The National Science Foundation has awarded DAPCEP a multi-year grant for young ladies designed to expose them to the Renewable Energy & Energy Efficiency Industries. This very prestigious award is in partnership with the following universities and corporations:

The program is scheduled to begin Fall 2010; student participants will be engaged in the DAPCEP Program for 2 years including a three week residential summer program at Michigan Technological University. **The entire program is being provided at no cost to the participant or her family.**

**On May 8, 2010 we will have an Open House & Registration for the 2nd cohort of student participants. The program is scheduled to begin Fall 2010. This two year program is for young ladies currently enrolled in the 8th grade with a minimum 2.0 GPA.** Courses will explore the world of Renewable Energy & Energy Efficiency industries; the program will also have a mentoring component and leadership & public speaking workshops.
